Dear Ware Families,

Happy Friday! On February 9, 2022, Commissioner Jeff Riley announced the DESE mask requirement will be lifted statewide as of February 28, 2022. With the Commissioner's announcement, masking policies will now revert to local control. The Board of Health will be meeting on February 16th to discuss their universal masking in schools, daycares, and all children's programs. In addition, on this day the school committee will meet to discuss their face mask policy. For those families who utilize the buses to get to school, per federal order face masks will be required on busses even after DESE's order is lifted.

Our new at-home COVID testing program has rolled out without many issues. Remember, we now have two testing initiatives that students and staff can take part in: Safety Check Testing (Pooled Testing) and/or the At-Home Test Kits. You can take part in both initiatives or in only one, your choice of which one.

Safety Check Testing (Pooled Testing)

To sign up for Safety Check Testing visit https://www.cic-health.com/consent/ma. This test is administered in school on Wednesdays.

When signing up for Safety Check Testing, you also have the option to consent for symptomatic testing, which will allow us to administer a rapid test if your child shows any symptoms of the virus while at school.
