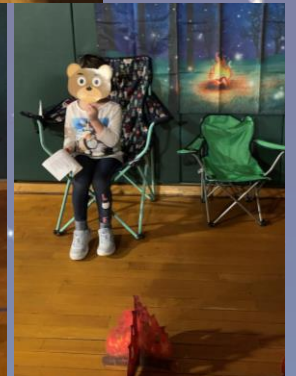


READING CAMP-IN

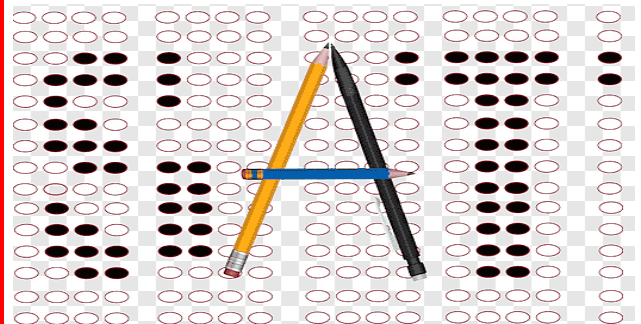

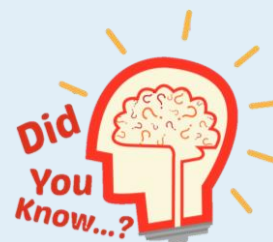
