

## **Comprehension Strategies to Practice at Home**

### **Questions to ask before reading:**

- What is the title of the book?
- What does the cover tell you about the book?
- What do you think the book is about?
- What are you curious to find out about this book?
- What do you already know about this book?
- What do you want to learn?
- Why are you reading this book?

### **Questions to ask during reading:**

- What do you think will happen next?
- What is the problem in the book?
- Why do you think the character did that?
- When you were reading this part, what were you picturing in your head?
- When you were reading, were there any confusing parts or words that you came across?

### **Questions to ask after reading:**

- Describe the setting of the story.
- Describe how a character changed throughout the book.
- Which of the characters did you like best? Why?
- What were some of the problems or situations the characters encountered?
- Tell about a part that you liked or disliked and tell why?
- What was the author's purpose for writing this text?
